


Year at a Glance

Inventory & difficult discussions

- Group Inventory held across 3 meetings
- Extra July 2025 meeting on sanctions & sensitive issues
- Members heard; discussions valuable

Internal needs

- Encourage more trusted servants
- Affirm the value of GSRs
- Develop constitution and P&Ps
- Clarify NSC role and responsibilities

PI Communications

PI team expands through UK events and email outreach, raising awareness of Codependence and CoDA Recovery.

Serving UK Fellowship

- Launch of our Newsletter with over 1000 new subscribers
- Following a survey and pre-CSC meeting, our delegates now carry the UK conscience to CSC

CoDA Sharing Guidelines

NSC has approved voluntary guidelines for focus and non-focus meetings and events (e.g. LGBTQIA+, neurodivergent, language, age, parenting, ethnic, colour or faith-based), supporting CoDA principles of safety and non-judgement.
