



BEHIND THE SCENES

- **Set up two factor authentication** on web accounts after access was gained to the UK website
- **Moved analytics** to a CoDA UK owned account
- **Performance issues** investigated. Excess components removed from website.
- **Stability issues** – managed instances when CoDA UK website crashed due to Wordpress launching a new version
- **CoDA teams across globe** - Outreach to and support for CoDA teams delivering CoDA events across regions (in person, hybrid, virtual)
- Supporting volunteers – **focus outreach** in locations with NO visible meetings



CoDA UK Public Info team 25/26

Delivering talks/print/digital libraries & digital outreach

- Invited to & delivering in person sessions, with literature packs via team of passionate volunteers across the UK
- Continued progress reaching out to Community sites, Councils, NHS, Publications
- Started offering digital libraries, alongside print libraries
- Received first query from team supporting under 18 community. Engaging with US CoDA Teen team
- Regained access to Linked Network (building connections with **hands on** members of community teams, and those teaching next gen.

CoDA UK Public Info

A core focus – 'comms challenge'

- Focusing outreach in regions with no visible CoDA presence (face to face meetings)
- Simplifying message to change discussion from who are CoDA, to meetings run 24/7
