

NSC Inventory Meeting 9th May 2026 – Agenda/Format

Previously scheduled for 21st March then 11th April, but only 4 / 5 members attended. Consensus felt this was too few for meaningful inventory, so postponed again to 9th May.

Introduction

In 2024 it was decided that the National Service Committee will take its inventory annually. Out of several options the chosen format was: [Twelve Traditions - CoDA.org](#), **CoDA Guidelines For Following The Twelve Traditions In Service Work**. All 12 Traditions were covered over three meetings in 2024 and 2025. Then another cycle was started in November 2025 when sharing took place on Traditions 1, 2 and 3; and in March, Traditions 4, 5 and 6.

An attempt was made at the first meeting to record and write up the sharing, but this proved to be questionable and impractical, so these inventory meetings are not recorded or minuted. You may wish to make your own notes in case you feel anything needs following up afterwards.

Today we are continuing the process. Before sharing on each Tradition we will read that Tradition, the short summary, and the Guideline questions. Sharing will be invited on **your** experience of the work and activity of the National Service Committee, such as:

- Attending the meetings,
- What the NSC does and how it works,
- Being a trusted servant participating at the NSC,
- Communications and any interaction with the NSC, etc.

Shares are not timed, and neither are the sections on each Tradition, apart from the approximate suggestions below. Completing them will take as long as it takes, but we will finish just before 3pm.

Whilst you are invited to share your experience freely, please be mindful of the time – it will be helpful if members' shares are reasonably concise.
